## Is your child ready for school?

### Preschool

- Physical
- TB Screening
- Lead Screening (Blood test strongly recommended)
- 3 Hepatitis B vaccines
- 4 DTaP vaccines
- 3 Polio vaccines
- 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- 1 Hib vaccine (1 or more doses)
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine **or** immunity proof
- Proof of age appropriate Pneumococcal vaccine(s)

### Kindergarten

- Physical
- Eye Exam
- Dental Exam
- Lead Screening (Blood test strongly recommended)
- 2 MMR vaccines (K-12)
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines **or** immunity proof (K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>)
- 3 or more doses of Polio vaccine (booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 4 or more doses of DTaP (booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)

### 2<sup>nd</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grades

- Dental Exam



## Dental

Peoria City/County Health Department.....679-6141

Dental services by appointment **ONLY**

School Exams: \$30 cash or Medicaid card at time of appointment

Students entering grades K, 2, and 6 will be required to show proof of a dental exam.

The Peoria City/County Health Department Dental Clinic accepts all Medicaid Insurances.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Physical
- 1 Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine given on or after 11th birthday (6<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup>)
- 1 Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) vaccine (6<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup>)
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines **or** immunity proof (6<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup>)
- 2 MMR vaccines
- 3 Hepatitis vaccines (proof series completed)

### 9<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Physical
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines or immunity proof (9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup>)

### 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine(s)
  - \* 2 doses with second dose at age 16 or later
  - \* 1 dose if given at age 16 or later

### Other recommended vaccines

- HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) vaccine: ages 11-12 and older if not yet completed
- Hepatitis A vaccine if not yet completed
